Reading: Nonfiction Features

We will be working nonfiction features folder project next week. Students will use what they have learned in the last ReadyGen module to apply it to a nonfiction book of their choice.

Writing: Narratives

Students spent time peer-editing and revising their narratives. We will be adding the final touches and work on their final drafts. These are to be turned in before they leave on break.

Math: Addition

We will continue to work with addition and strategies to solve story problems. We will also revisit place value and rounding before break. When they come back refreshed, we will tackle subtraction (tough concept for students).
