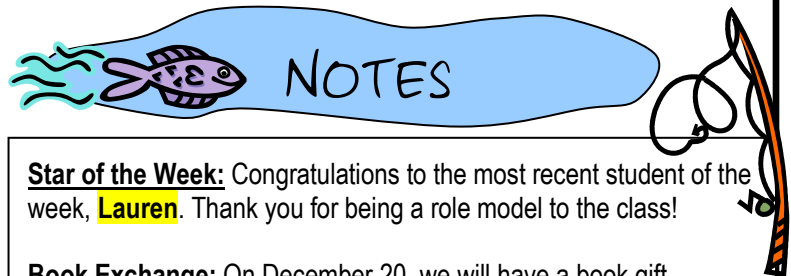
Math: Addition
