We will begin discussing types of writing and the writing process. Students will have an opportunity to brainstorm ideas for their fictional narratives.

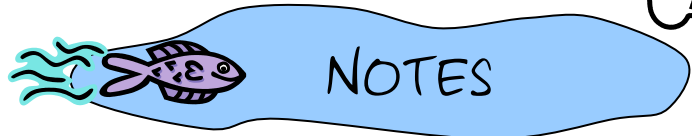
Math: Multiplication
